last Will and Testamant in manner following (viz.)

I Begueath my soule to Almighty God that gave it me and my Body
to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like manner at the
Descretion of my Executors

Item - I Will and desire that my well beloved Wif for whom I shall have
lent, that is to say I levd her all & every thing Estate both Real and
Personal for and during the time she continues my widdow no longer
and in case my said wife should marry or doe make

Witnessed this my day & date, the 11th day of January, 1811, and signed
Item - I Well and desire that after the Death of my wife Susannah
Wife Susannah that all my Goods, Labour and Money shall be
divided equally between my self and my
children (legit) break them, keep them, let them divide
and whereas the last mentioned Lucy Anne Spicer being born
Illegitimate, yet I acknowledge her my Child, and entitle her
that she shall have her equal share of my Estate with the
rest of my Children - - -

Item - And whereas my said wife was bereft of all Children & Husband
desire that the said Child of mine, Lucy Anne Spicer shall have her portion
and Providence among of my other Children before mentioned
Item - I nominate constitute and appoint my Son Edward Fletcher
Benjamin Spicer, my well beloved Brother William Spicer
and Fletcher & Mrs. James Head to be the Executors
of this my Last will and Testament, Utterly Revoking, Reannulling
and Disallowing, all former Wills, Testaments and Bequests in
any wise whatsoever same made & done, and acknowledged by

any wife whatsoever by me made & done, and the same being so,
this and only this to be my Last Will & Testament, In Testimony
whereof I do hereunto set my hand & seal the day and year
above written ~
