Will Parish of St Thomas being of sound and disposing Mind and Memory do make &
Declare this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following.

Principally I most humbly Implore the Mercy of Almighty God through the Merits
of Jesus Christ to instant eternal life and Happiness my Body to be Decently Bur-
ied at the Discretion of my Executors herein After Named and as for my Estate
Both real and Personal I give and Dispose thereof as follows. Impressed I Desire
That all such Debts as I shall justly owe at the Time of my Death and my Funeral
Charges and Expences be in the first place paid by my Executors and Executors
Herein After Named

I do hereby give unto my Daughter Mary Ann Beale which is now Mrs
James Madwarina Charles Beale Containing about Eight hundred and Eight Acres
more or less to her and the heirs forever also my Three Negroes Candice, Cecily and the
I do hereby give to my Daughter Cecily and Sarah I give to my Daughter in Law

Christa Sarah but the two last mentioned Emily and Sarah I gave to my Daughter in Law
of a Negro Girl named Minny who was given to me by her Sister Mary Miller before her
Marriage with M^r W^m Danglefield in a Deed Executed in Orange County by this William
Danglefield bearing date the Twenty seventh day of August 1763 which Negro Girl
Minny for Sunday M^r Danglefield sold to one Thomas Stewart but in executing
Daughter Molly her heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns or either of them or any
other person or persons whatsoever should at any Time hereafter sue for and recover the
Money or any of the Increase thereof as my Will that the part or portion of my Estate which I
have Devised and Bequeathed unto my said Daughter Molly shall be liable and subject
to the Person or Persons from whom this Money or any of the Increase should be recovered
for all such Damages as shall be obtained by such recovery
Then I give and Devise unto my Daughter Anne my Land which I bought of Anthony
Lamont in Albemarle County and my Land which I bought of W^m Richard in

Orange County and adjoining the Land that I bought of Anthony Demand to
her and her heirs forever. Item I desire that one hundred pounds current money
may be Raised out of the Profits of my Estate and laid out by my Executors for
Land adjoining or so convenient as can be got to the Land which I have I have
Given unto my said Daughter Anne Which Land When purchased I give and
Devise unto my ^d Daughter Anne and her heirs forever But if my Executors
should not think it proper or advantageous to lay these Hundred pounds out in
Land Which I leave Entirely at their Discretion; then in that Case I give and
Bequeath these Money to my said Daughter Anne and her heirs forever And
for the more certain having these one hundred pounds as well as the Support
of my Wife Elizabeth and the Maintenance and Education of all my Children
I hereby Direct and give my Desire that all my Estate be kept Together and
undivided (excepting the hundred pounds herein before bequeathed for the
Purchase of a parcel or Tract of Land) Untill my Daughter Molly When the
Age of Eighteen years or Marry or Untill my said Wife Eliza shall Marry at
either of Which Times that shall first happen I then give and Bequeath

unto my Dear Wife Elizabeth in Lieu of her Dowry in my Land all my household

and Kitchen furniture to be her Absolute property forever and all the rest and

Residue of my Estate not herein before disposed of I give and Bequeath at the

Discretion of my said Dear Wife and Children to be Equally Divided

Amongst them Share and Share alike forever And Whereas I trust and hope

that my said Dear Wife Eliza will give her Land Whereas I now live to my

Daughter Melmed and her heirs forever But in case my said Wife should

refuse or neglect to give this Land to her then in that case my Will and

Desires are I do hereby direct that each of my Other Daughters Mellyd Lane

shall pay to my Daughter Melmed Within three years after they come to the

possession of their Estates one hundred pounds each Money of price And I do hereby

I do hereby constitute and appoint my Beloved Wife then Eliza my Trustee

to execute the same and W. William Campbell Esq. of the County of Essex

of this my Will declaring that my said Estate may not be apprehended nor my
Breaching Making Null and Void all and every Will and Wills to me herebefore
made Declaring this Only to be my Last Will and Testament in Writing Whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 15 day of August 1768

to make my said Daughter Molly ample Satisfaction and recompence

for the said Lilly and her Child Sarah I do hereby give and Bequeath unto her my

for the said Emily and her Child Sarah I do hereby give and Bequeath unto her my
said Daughter Wholly in full of the said Emily and Sarah The sum of Fifty pounds but
Money Which I am I give and Bequeath unto her upon the same Conditions and under
The same Restrictions as I had bequeathed the said Emily and Sarah to be in my above
lasted Will and I do hereby ratify and confirm my said Will in all respects hereby
Vowed or uttered and Declare this to be my last Will and to be taken as part of my last
Will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
Seventeenth day of June one Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Nine
