 knowing how soon it may please God to take me out of this Transitory world
 Therefore first and principally recommend my soul to God who give it me
 Through the merits of my blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and my Body to
 be Buried in a Christian manner And as to what Worldly good it shall please
 God of his great mercy to bestow on me I give & Bequeath as follows viz
 I Give and Bequeath to my dear and beloved wife Mary Dawson All my Real &
 Personal Estate During her life or Widowhood after her Death or Marriage
 to be equally Divided amongst my children and if any of them should die
 before the division of the Estate for their parts to be equally Divided Between
 their children lawful & natural of their lives And if any of them should die
 without issue for their parts to be equally Divided between the rest of

my children I therefore desire that my wife Mary Dawson and my son Robert Dawson be the Executors of my Estate. Witness my hand and seal this 30 day of January 1798.
