

In the name of God amen I Samuel George of the County of Orange and
District of South Carolina being sick and weak in body through of age and perfect
sense & memory thank be to God and calling to mind the Mortality of man and
knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to Die do constitute and appoint this
to be my last will and testament as follows to wit I do hereby give and bequeath to my
Widow Anne George all my Personal Estate which she holds in fee simple
of the same during her widowhood and in case she marry and any child or
children of the Estate appear I nominate & appoint David George & John Jones of
Prince William County Executors of this my last will & Testament to take
the same out of her hands for the benefit of the Children except sufficient
security be given and in case no wife or damage appear I appoint her my
Widow to take the same of this my last will & Testament during her
Natural Life and after her death to be Equally Divided between my
Children then surviving I desire that my Estate shall not be appraised
During her widowhood I give to my son James George one whole
Acre of land upon my plantation near George one black man with all her
furniture and also her by descent & make void all other wills or
wishes whatever was made by me and do this & do confirm this to be my
last and testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this Twentieth day of November 1745

This last Will and Testament of Samuel George was presented
into Court by Patience George the Executrix thereof and proved by
the Oaths of John Wharton & James George the Witnesses thereto and Ordered
to be recorded and on the Motion of the said Executrix who made Oath according
to Law Certificate is granted for obtaining Letters of Probate thereof and
for giving security on which she with John Christopher & Thomas Newman
her securities entered into and Acknowledged their Obedience to his Majesty's
Administration of the said Decedent's Estate
