weak but of sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God for the
same Do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth
I Give and Bequeath my Soul to God who gave it and my body to be decently interred
at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter mentioned. Item my Will and desire
that all my Lands Mannors and other Estate be sold as soon after my death as my Executors
can make convenient who I desire will give eighteen months credit to the purchaser
they giving bond with approved security. And the money arising from such Sale
I give and Bequeath in the following manner (my just debts & funeral charges being first
paid). Item I give and Bequeath to my Grandson William Parnell son to David
Parnell Twenty pounds current money to be delivered to David Parnell who I ap-
point to take care of his money until he arrives to the age of Twenty five years
and that he the said David Parnell may put his money to usury and bestow the
interest on him annually. I Give and Bequeath to my Grand daughter Sarah
Baker Morton Parnell Daughter to William Parnell Twenty Pounds current money
to be in the care of my son William Parnell who I do appoint to put the said money
to usury and the interest arising to be bestowed on her said Daughter until she arrives to the
age of twenty years at which time I desire that she may receive the Twenty Pounds.
Item I Give and Bequeath to my Grandson Francis Parnell son to my daughter
Francis Baker Twenty pounds current money to be put to interest until he arrives
to the age of Twenty one years and the interest to be bestowed on him annually by his
mother who I appoint to manage the said money so given or whosoever she may appoint
to do so.

at a future day and of the said Gerard Banks should and before he arrives
age of twenty one years my will is that my daughter Frances Banks have the said
money so given to her son. Item I give and Bequeath to my Grand Daughter
Sarah Bache Hunkin Twenty pounds current money to remain in the hands
of my Executors until she arrive to the age of Twenty years who I appoint to put
the money to interest and bestow her the said Interest annually. Item I give and
Bequeath to Sarah Ann's Daughter to Patience Hunkin Ten pounds current
money to remain in the hands of William Paterson's Mother who I appoint to put said
money to Interest and bestow the Interest Annually on the said Sarah Hunkin
until she arrive to the age of Twenty one years at which time I reserve to myself
receive the said Ten pounds above mentioned and of the Interest thereof. I desire that
should die before she arrives to the age of Twenty one years of my will and desire is
that my daughter Frances Banks have the said Ten pounds intended for the said Sarah
Hunkin. Item I give and Bequeath to the first child that my son Joseph Bache
may have born (lawfully begotten) Twenty pounds current money to be in the care
of Frances Banks who I desire to put the money to Interest until the said Child
arrive to the age of Ten years and then to receive the said Twenty pounds & Interest
and if it so happen that the said Joseph Bache should never have a Child lawfully
begotten then my desire is that my daughter Frances Banks have the said Twenty
pounds.
And I desire that all the remainder of my Estate be equally
divided between my son William Paterson's Mother my Daughter Frances Banks
