& afterwards I give the said Wenny & her Increase to Rush Hudson Jan^r.

Except the first born I give to Elizabeth Hudson & the Next to Mary Hudson

I give to my Son Rush all the rest of my goods to dispose with as he shall

think proper, and finally I make & ordain my Son Rush Hudson full & whole

 Oath according to Law Certificate was granted him for obtaining Letters
 of probate thereof in due form giving Security on which he with Joshua
 Hudson & John Morton his Sureties entered into & acknowledged their
 Bond for the same on the Sum of Twenty pounds Current Money
