

The Court held for Orange County on Thursday the 23 of August 1769
William Walker returned into Court this his Guardian Account of Mary Money
who made Oath to the same & Ordered to be Recorded Test Geo Taylor. 636

In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Walker of the County of Orange and
Colony of Virginia being in good health and of sound and Disposing mind and
memory for which I hope God to make & Ordain this my Last Will and Testament
in manner and form following that is to say I will that all such debts and charges be en-
tirely paid at the time of my death and my funeral expenses and charges be en-
tirely paid by my Executors herein after named and as for my Estate
both Real and Personal I direct them as follows.

I give and bequeath the tract of Land wherein I now live
containing about 100 acres and twenty acres during his natural life & after
his death I give and bequeath said Land and Garden to my wife
the youngest daughter of the late John Bankes and her husband

I also bind unto my said wife during her marriage to me
Jack Joe & Lucy and after her death I give & bequeath to my said wife Lucy of her
tunis to give her 2 Negroes Jack & James Walker my Grandson the son of Thomas
Walker my son, And I give the said Negroes Jack & James Walker to my
son of James Walker And I give that Negro Lucy and her future increase to my
son Charles Walker. Item I give and Bequeath to my Grandson James Walker
the son of Thomas Walker two Negro children named Barbry & Ann. Also I give
Bequeath to my Grandson Thomas Walker the son of Thomas Walker a mulatto
boy slave named Lewis. Item I give & Bequeath to my Grandson Thomas Walker
the son of James Walker two negroes Barbry & her Daughter Rachel. Also I give
and Bequeath to my Grand daughter Joyce Walker One Negro girl named Milley
Item I give to my son Charles Walker three negroes bequeathed him by his
uncle, T Pitts Also I give & Devise to my said Son Charles On a tract of land
bearing about one hundred and twenty acres lying in the County of
having already paid the sum of Thirty pounds Current Money to my son
Thomas Walker for the the said Land to him & his heirs forever. I also give
Devise unto my said Son Charles my land that lies on Pottys Creek

I Devise unto my said Son Charles my land that lies on Brothys Creek
containing about three hundred and twenty Acres to him & his heirs forever
Item I also give unto my Grand son Thomas Walker the son of James, my

Copper Mill and its furniture. I give and Bequeath all the
rest and residue of my Estate of what kind or quality soever not before

bequeathed or devised to be equally divided between my wife Mary his Son

Thomas & Charles & my Grand son Thomas Walker the son of James Walker

to be their sole property forever. And I do hereby Command and Ordain

My son Charles Walker my true successor to the sum of £ 1000 I demand

and do also direct and it is my Will and Desire that my two Grandchildren

shall have and enjoy the several legacies which I have bequeathed to my

Grand children to his own proper use until my 2 Grandsons shall attain

the age of twenty one years and my Grand daughter the age of eighteen

years after birth when that she the 2^d child to maintain and provide my

2^d Grand children James & Lydia Walker until they be their birth and

Reciting the said Testimony last Will & Testament of the above named
set my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of January One thousand seven hundred
and Sixty three
