

A Court held for Orange County on Thursday the 22 of August 1769
William Walker returned into Court this his Guardian Account of Mary Mary
who made Oath to the same & Ordered to be Recorded Test Geo. Taylor C.C.

In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Walker of the County of Orange and
Colony of Virginia being in good health and of sound and Disposing mind and
memory for which I bless God do make & Ordain this my Last Will and Testament
in manner and form following, that is to say I will that all such debts as I shall
justly owe at the time of my death and my Funeral expences and Charges be in
the first place paid by my Executors herein after named And as for my Estate
both Real and Personal I dispose thereof as followeth

I bequeath & give unto my wife Elizabeth the Tract of Land whereon I now live
containing about two hundred & ninety Acres during her natural life & after
her death I give & devise the said Tract of Land to my Grandson Thomas Walker
the son of James Walker and my wife to him and his heirs forever

I also lend unto my said wife during her natural life my negroes

Jack Joe & Lucy and after her death, I give & bequeath the said three Negroes as follows to wit, I give the said Negro Jack to James Walker my Grandson the son of Thomas

Walker my son, And I give the said Negro Joe to my Grandson Thomas Walker the son of James Walker And I give the said Negro Lucy and her future Increase to my

son Charles Walker. Item I give and Bequeath to my Grandson James Walker

the son of Thomas Walker two Negro Children named Barbary & Dinah I also give

& Bequeath to my Grandson Thomas Walker the son of Thomas Walker one male boy whose name is Lewis. Item I give & Bequeath to my Grandson Thomas Walker

the son of James Walker two negroes Barbary & her Daughter Rachel I also give

and Bequeath to my Grand daughter Joyce Walker One Negro Girl named Milley

Item I give to my son Charles Walker three negro boys named Ben Duquesne, Elias

Ducain, & Pats. Also I give & Devise to my said son Charles One Tract of Land

containing about one hundred and fifty acres of land (part of the land of the said son

having already paid the sum of Thirty pounds Current Money to my son

Thomas Walker for the the said Land) to him & his heirs forever I also give

& Devise unto my said son Charles my land that lies on Pottys Creek

I Devise unto my said son Charles my land that lies on Potters Creek
containing about three hundred and twenty Acres to him & his heirs forever
Item I also give unto my Grand son Thomas Walker the son of James, my
Copper Mill and its furniture Lastly I give and Bequeath all the
rest and residue of my Estate of what kind or Quality never not before
bequeathed or devised to be Equally Divided between my Wife, my two sons
Thomas & Charles & my Grand son Thomas Walker the son of James Walker
to be their sole property forever And I do hereby Constitute and Appoint
my son Charles Walker my sole Executor to this my last Will & Testament
And do also direct and it is my Will and Desire that my said son Charles
shall have and enjoy the several legacies which I have bequeathed to my
Grand Children to his own proper use untill my 3^d Grand sons shall attain
the age of twenty one years and my Grand daughter the age of eighteen
years upon condition that he the said Charles do maintain and educate my
two Grand Children Thomas & James Walker suitably to their condition and

fortune and so on my name in some
declaring this to be my last Will & Testament In witness whereof I have caused
at my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of January One thousand seven hundred
and sixty seven
