 I give & bequeath my body I yield to the Earth to be buried in such

Christian like manner as to my Executors herein after named  
shall see meet, and as to such movable Estate as it shall  
pleased God to bestow on me I give devise and bequeath the  
same in manner and form following.

First I Give unto my Beloved wife Sarah all my Lands and Tenements  
as Estate During her Natural Life or Widows hood to Raise  
And maintain my Children or and out her Death or marriage.

Item I Give and devise to my son James all the Lands whereon I now  
live to him and his heirs for ever Except my wife shall bring  
forth a male Child in nine months from this date and if  
that Child arrives to the age of twenty one years

Item Then I give and devise all my Lands Equally to be divided Between  
my son James and my other son to them and their heirs for ever

Item I Give and devise to my Daughter Mary and my Daughter Elizabeth  
all my Personal Estate to be Equally Divided between  
them Except my wife brings a female Child in nine months from  
this date then that Child to have an Equal Part of my Personal

Estate before mentioned to my three Daughters  
I vest in the Power of my beloved wife Sarah and my other Co-  
here after named to give any Part of my Personal Estate to any  
of my Daughters at marriage to be valued by any three Justices  
of the County aforesaid and the Value to be in part of the said Daughters  
Portion and Lastly I do appoint my beloved wife Sarah and my Brother  
John Fleet and Francis Gibbs my Co-Executors and Executors of this  
my last will and Testament Respecting and making null and  
void all other wills by me heretofore made declaring this only to  
be my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have  
set my hand and seal this thirteenth day of April one thousand

seven hundred and seventy three
