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Brother Charles she told that some of the men named Lightfoot
Last Spring and I leave some father in law William Buchanan
my last. I order and approve that my daughter be
brought up and Educated by ^{my} wife during her minority and no part
of her deageies be conserved or made use of for her education
Tenthly and if she dies in her minority I order her deageies to be distributed
in the following manner (Viz) that my Father Patrick Campbell
have the sole Right and property thereof and if to be by him
disposed of at his pleasure either in whole or part some
or more of his Relations and and I hereby approve James Campbell
and William Christian to be the Executors and Administrators of this
my last will and Testament hereby disavowing Dissenting and
making void all former wills and Testaments by me formerly
made confirming this only to be my last will and Testament to
Witness my hand and seal this 11th day of November anno Dom
1744
