Thomas Robbons to satisfy him for a debt I am owing the said

Robbons being security for me for fifteen pounds the whole amount
Thirty pounds becometh me and of Wm. & my will & devise is that
Edward Watts do make said Robbons a good and lawfull Right to
said Land & my Executors see that there is a writ made for said
Land also one parcel of Land I purchased of Edward Pigg containing
by Survey 100 Acres which I give the said Robbons for the above
consideration & that Robbons is to sell said Land & if any money more
than pays him the 2^d Libt. that then Robbons is to return it to my 6th
Children
