County of Orange being very sick & weak in Body though in perfect Sense
Mind & Memory at Frankfurt is solemnly & fully for it, & make approved this
my last Will & Testament in Presence of Seven following good & lawfull
men to God who gave it & my Body to the Earth to be decently buried at
the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named & as touching my worldly
estate wherein He hath pleased God to endow me. First my Will & Desire is
that all my just Debts & funerals expenses be paid then I give & bequeath unto
my youngest Son John Pratt one hundred & thirty Acres of Land including my
Plantation with a Line across the bridge between the two Broadham Church to him
& his Heirs ~~as appurtenances~~ for ever. Item my Will & Desire is that the rest of my
Land should be equally divided between my other two Sons John & William Pratt
from the Line before mentioned up the bridge between the aforesaid Broadham
Church to the upper Part or back. I give the second Part bounding upon a
Line of Dean White I give & bequeath unto my Son John Pratt of the Eastward
Part I give & bequeath unto my Son William Pratt to him his Heirs & assigns forever
My Will & Desire is that all the rest of my Estate should be equally divided among
my five Children Viz John Pratt, William Pratt, John Pratt, Sarah Broadham
and Anne Manthorpe. further my Will & Desire is that my beloved Wife Anne
Pratt should & may enjoy & possess that Part of Land given to my Son John
Pratt together with every Part & Parcel of my Personal Estate so long as
she shall live & as long as she should change her State of Life by Marriage
then my Will & Desire is that my Estate should be taken out of her Hands
and divided as before mentioned. In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto

and Anne Manhopole, further my Will & Desire is that my beloved Wife Anne
Pratt shall & may enjoy & possess that Part of Land given to my
Pratt together with every Part & Parcel of my Personal Estate not long as
she shall live excepting she should change her State of Life by Marriage
then my Will & Desire is that my Estate should be taken out of her Hands
and accorded in before mentioned Estate. This will was confidentially appointed my
beloved Son W^m Pratt & my well beloved Wife Anne Pratt Seal & Signature
of this my last Will & Testament In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & Seal this first Day of March 1748
