Price widow of Hutchings B. Price deceased and named
in the will of my deceased husband as aforesaid do
by these presents solemnly relinquish all right, title
claim and interest of whatever nature kind and de-
scription as one of the Advisors and Legatus mentioned
in said will as fully, effectually and to the same in-
tent and purpose as if said will had never been
made, with the intention in so doing of claiming and
taking my interest in said estate left by the said
Hutchings B. Price in the same manner and to
the same extent as though he had died intestate
as to his real and personal estate and the same were
distributed according to the acts of descent and dis-
tributions by the Legislature of Virginia in such
case made and provided - and the said Frances
J. Price for myself my heirs &c do by these pres-
ents with the Advisors Distributed

into covenant to and with the Aforesaid Distributors
and heirs at Law of the said Hutchings B. Price
Accessed that from and after the date of this
Deed of Renunciation that I will not claim
or demand out of the estate of the said Hutchings
B. Price ~~only one third~~ of the Real estate and
one third of the Slaves for my life, and one
third of ^{the} money on hand, debts due the estate and
one third of the proceeds arising from the sale
of the other personal property absolutely after
the payment of the debts of said estate, the
provision in my behalf in the Will of the said
Access to the contrary notwithstanding and
further obligate myself my heirs & firmly by these
~~present~~ that upon the assignment to me of one third
of the land belonging to the estate of the said Hutch-
ings B. Price at the time of his death, and one third

of the slaves of said estate to be held by me as and for
my dower interest in the land and slaves belonging
to said estate and also upon my receiving one third
of the money on hand, debts due to said estate and
the proceeds arising from the sale of other property
belonging to the same, that I will not sue for, claim
or demand any other portion of the estate of the said
Hutchings B. Price either real or personal the pro-
visions in his said last will and Testament in my
favor to the contrary notwithstanding. In Testimony
