Item 3^d I give to my son William B. Banks my negro
woman Mary and his children with their future increase
to him and his heirs forever and also confirm all advancements
made to him by me.

Item 4th I give to my Daughter Francis Ann Banks negro girl Sarah with her future increase to her and her heirs forever, and I also hereby ratify and confirm the gift heretofore made by me to my said Daughter of negro woman Hannah and her children ~

Item 5th I give to my Daughter Louisa B. Banks negro girl Ellen with all her future increase to her and her heirs forever, and do hereby confirm and ratify the gift hereafter heretofore made by me to my said Daughter of negro woman Harriett and her children ~

Item 6th I give to my Daughter Susan L. Banks negro girl Agnes with all future increase to her and her heirs forever hereby confirming and ratifying the gift heretofore made by me to my said Daughter of negro girl Eliza and her future increase ~

Item 7th I give to my Daughter Mariack B. Pannell five dollars having heretofore given her more of my estate than I shall be able to give to either of my other children ~

Item 8th It is my will and desire that after the death of my wife Susan W. Banks, all my estate given to her in the 3^d clause of this my will which she shall not have disposed of by advancements to my children under the power vested in her in said clause be equally divided between my son Wm. B. Banks and my Daughters Frances Ann Banks, Louisa B. Walkeup, and Susan W. Banks to them and their heirs forever.

Item 9th Lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my friends Richard Logan, Thomas S. Flourney and William W. Tinsdale Executors of this my last will and Testament - In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this the 19th day of January 1847.

Flournoy one of the Executors in the will named who made oath and with J. B. Storall, Charles S. Larrington and Wm J. H. McEwen his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ~~one thousand dollars~~ conditioned as the law directs, ~~certificates~~ was granted him for obtaining probate of said will in due form. The other Executors in the will nominated ~~of said will~~ ~~for~~ ~~the~~ the probate.
