death of my said wife after which my said
daughter to have the use of only the two rooms

Dick and Coleman during her life and
at her death I dispose of them as her own
after divided. Also I give & bequeath to
my said wife one equal third part of
all my house hold & kitchen furniture
plantation utensils & stock of every kind

to her & her heirs forever except one half of my yoke
of Oxen & Ox Cart and horse. Bonapart the whole
of which horse together with the half of the Oxen
Ox Cart I give to my said wife to her & her heirs
forever.

I give to my daughter Lucy Bonnell to her & her heirs
forever one bed & furniture together with fifty dollars
in cash to be paid by my Executor & ~~after~~ after
all my debts shall have been paid.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Taylor
for & during her life the following negroes named Rhoda
& Aaron and one bed & furniture, with the boy John
man at the death of my wife. that is, the said ^{boy} John
man at the death of my wife. At the death of my
said daughter Elizabeth I give & bequeath the said
property with the increase of the female slave if
any, to the Children of my said daughter living at
the death and should any of my said daughters
Children die before a decision of the said the Child
I give & bequeath Rhoda & Aaron & the said

Children die before a decision of the said the Children of such deceased Child to have a share in the same -

I give & bequeath to my daughter Martha Lewis to her heirs & assigns forever one equal half of my land subject to the loan made to my wife together with the following negroes namely Sally Humphrey Nancy Minny and Stephen also.

Jeff & Beck at the death of my wife together with one half of Yoke of Oxen & one Cart and one equal third part of all my household & kitchen furniture plantation utensils and other stock except the horse & half of yoke of oxen before given to my wife.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Marriett to her heirs & assigns forever the following negroes namely Kit & Aggy at the death of my wife & my John Murren and Eliza Jane also one equal half of my land subject to the loan to my wife & according to quality in the possession of which I wish to be

I give & bequeath to my daughter Martha Lewis
to her heirs & assigns forever one equal half
of my land subject to the loan made to my wife
together with the following negroes namely Sally
Mumphy Nancy Minny and Stephen. also

Jose & Beck at the death of my wife together with
one half of Yoke of Oxen & one Cart and one equal
third part of all my household & kitchen furniture
& plantation utensils and other stock except the
horse & half of yoke of oxen before given to my wife

I give & bequeath to my daughter Marcella to her
heirs & assigns forever the following negroes namely
Neil & Aggy at the death of my wife & my John
Muhammad & Eliza Jane. also one equal half of my
land subject to the loan to my wife & according to
quantity in the division of which I wish to be
skin Creek to be the line as far as it will be
proper in a division made according to a just

valuation - I also give & bequeath to my said daughter Harriett the remaining third part of my stock household & kitchen furniture and plantation utensils -

Instead of giving to my wife one third of the household & kitchen furniture plantation utensils stock & that of my yoke of oxen & ox cart absolutely as her own before stated - I give & bequeath the same at the death of my said wife to my daughter Martha & Harriett to be equally divided between them to them & their heirs forever -

My further will and desire is that my Executor herein after named for managing my estate as contemplated by the first clause herein shall have one seventh of the proceeds & profits thereof after a good sufficient supply for my wife & daughters support as well as for his own family it being my intention hereby for him to conduct my estate & affairs after my death until it is time

I hereby constitute and appoint my
beloved wife Nancy Executrix and my son
in law David P. Lewis Executor of this my
last will and testament revoking all other
wills by me heretofore made and I desire that
