 and appraisement of the Estate of Benjamin Dickson was returned to Court and is as follows

In the name of God Amen I Ann Dickson of Powhatan County and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
 and ninety two on the fourth day of January of the above mentioned year being in perfect health and sound memory
 but knowing it is appointed by God for me to die, I do hereby bequeath my body to the earth from whence it came and my soul to
 God hoping he will have mercy on me I therefore ordain this to be my last will and testament giving my worldly effects
 in the following manner I do give and bequeath unto Betty Roberts of Chesterfield County a negro woman by
 the name of Betty and her increase to her and her heirs forever I also give her one feather bed and all my wearing
 apparel I also give to Maria Roberts husband to the said Betty Roberts one horse by the name of Jack a brown filly and
 bequeath to William Wilgus of Powhatan County five shillings in cash and three barrels of Corn Irish Whisky and
 bequeath to my friend John Eagan who lives with me at the present all my cash and household furniture and a
 horse by the name of Buck also all my linen and grain likewise that shall remain any property at my death and
 I do appoint him my heir to receive all my estate and to be my sole executor I do appoint John Eagan and
 Edward Watkins to be my Executors my will and desire is that my estate be not appraised
