Will and Testament of William Harris deceased was presented
in court and proved by the oaths of Roderick Landon Anthony
Martin and Daniel Branch witnesses thereto and ordered to
be recorded And on the petition of Thomas Harris an executor
thereof named who made oath thereto and together with
Vincent Markham Roderick Landon and Jordan Anthony
his securities entered into and acknowledged that he paid
the penalty of five thousand pounds conditional as the Probate
court certificate is granted him for obtaining probate of
the said will in due form

In the name of god amen I George Corbin of
County being sick and weak that of a sound and perfect memory do
make this my last will and Testament in manner and form
following.

I Give and bequeath to my son John Corbin my father's bed
furniture to him and his heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha Corbin my father's bed
furniture likewise and her share out of my stock of horses
her and her heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath to my Son Robert Corbin my father's bed
furniture to him and his heirs forever.

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I give and bequeath to my son Bartlett Cox one feather bed and furniture
to him and his heirs forever
I leave the land and plantation whereon I now live containing
four hundred Acres with all my slaves and stock of every kind
(except the horse that my Daughter Martha was sold for) to be
sold upon eighteen months credit from the day of sale the
purchaser giving Bond and security to carry interest from
from the date if not punctually paid by the day and the
money arising from that sale to be divided in manner and
form following

I give and bequeath to my son George Cox forty pounds to him and
his heirs forever I give and bequeath to my son John Cox forty
pounds to him and his heirs forever I give and bequeath to my son
Martha Cox forty pounds to her and her heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my Grand son George Thompson
one of my Daughters Sally Thompson forty pounds
to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my son Robert Cox twenty pounds to
him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my son Bartlett Cox forty pounds to him
and his heirs forever I give and bequeath to my Daughter Isabella
Daniel forty pounds to her and her heirs forever

I leave the balance of the money arising from the before mentioned
sale of my after my debt are paid my Will is that
be equally divided among all my Children except Sally Thompson
and that her son George Thompson should have his part
and to be paid
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the purchasers giving Bond and security to carry Interest
from the date if not punctually paid by the day and the
money arising from that sale to be divided in manner
following
I give and bequeath to my son George Cog forty pounds to him
and his heirs forever I give and bequeath to my son John Cog
to him and his heirs forever I give and bequeath to my
daughter Martha Cog forty pounds to her and her heirs forever
I give and bequeath to my Grand son George Thompson
fourty pounds to him and his heirs forever I give and bequeath
to my Daughter Sally Thompson forty pounds
to her and her heirs forever
I give and bequeath to my son Robert Cog twenty pounds to
him and his heirs forever
I give and bequeath to my son Daniel Cog forty pounds to him
and his heirs forever I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Sally Daniel forty pounds to her and her heirs forever
When the Balance of the money arising from the before mentioned
sale of any of the say Debt are paid my Will is that
be equally divided among all my Children except Sally Thompson
and that her son George Thompson should have his part
and to be put out upon interest untill he comes of age if he be
any years my children as follows Henry Cog George Cog John
Cog John Cog Martha Cog Sally Thompson George Thompson
standing in her place as above directed Robert Cog Daniel
Cog and Abraham Cog if he ever returns
to them and their heirs forever

them and further my will is that my children beforementioned Sally
Thompson standing in their own place should equally divide
among themselves the Ballance of the household and Kitchen
or furniture and that I give to them and their heirs forever
I nominate constitute and appoint Joseph Thompson
Henry Daniel and my Son John my Executors to this
my last will and Testament revoking all other wills
by me before made and acknowledging this to be my
last and only will In Witness whereof I have hereunto
to set my hand & affixed my seal this thirty first day
of October in the year of our Lord God one thousand
seven hundred and ninety four
