part of the tract of Land whereon Snow live lying on the East  
of the Road leading from the meadow to the main Road  
Item I give and devise to my son William <sup>Shoof</sup> ~~Shoof~~ Mr Thomas Tupper and my  
widow to him and his heirs and assigns forever

Item I give and devise to my son William <sup>Baskerville</sup> ~~Baskerville~~ the following  
Negroes Fanny Lucy Rachel Anthony Matt Fanny etc. betwixt Lucy Matt  
Anne also make George Rob Charlman and Leisy with their furniture  
to him and his heirs and assigns forever

Item I give and devise to my son Samuel Baskerville and  
William Baskerville Baskerville proper will be them and their  
heirs and assigns forever Item I give and devise to my son  
Baskerville the following Negroes Roger Betty Ann Wollt Trade  
and Dena with one feather bed and furniture belonging to it  
to him his heirs and assigns forever

Item I give and devise to my son Richard Parker all my feather beds and furniture  
 belonging to him but his own and signs for ever when I give and devise to my son  
 Richard Parker all my children the following negroes first Pass Tucker and the negro  
 girl Sarah that now lives with him and it is my will and intention that the said  
 negroes shall be kept together till John Parker shall die of the said Richard and his  
 of lawful age then I give the said negroes to the forever of my son Richard Parker  
 children to him and then I give for ever them after my grand son John Parker  
 with my son Richard Parker because of lawful age I will give him the said negroes  
 to the forever of my son Richard Parker unless he shall die and then I will  
 give the said negroes to my son George Parker and his heirs forever  
 to my daughter Magdalene Traber the following negroes James and  
 James mulatto Jimmy and Pass to her and her heirs forever  
 Item I give and devise to my son Samuel Parker all the land he has and  
 his heirs forever and after my debts before mentioned is paid that my son  
 Samuel Parker do pay to my daughter Magdalene Traber thirty  
 pounds current money but should the said negroes be due to her  
 payment of my said debts then I will make my son Samuel Parker  
 executor of from the payment of thirty pounds current money to my  
 daughter Magdalene Traber to her heirs forever  
 Item I give and devise to my son Samuel Parker all the land he has and  
 his heirs forever but should the said negroes Charles or Bob be due  
 payment of my debts already mentioned then I will make my son Samuel  
 Parker executor of from the payment of one hundred pounds to the said  
 or receiver of my son Richard Parker children them I give and  
 to my son Samuel Parker one half of my stock of Sheep and Hogs to  
 him and his heirs forever them I give and devise to my son William  
 Parker the other half of my stock of Sheep and Hogs to him and  
 his heirs forever them I give and devise all my stock of Cattle Horses Swine  
 Cows to be equally divided between my sons George Parker and  
 Parker Samuel Parker William Parker Parker Parker  
 my daughter Magdalene Traber to them and their heirs forever  
 Item I give and devise to my son Samuel Parker and to William  
 Parker Parker all my household and kitchen furniture not  
 mentioned else my will and intention with the plantation the

his heirs forever and after my debts before mentioned is paid that my son  
Samuel Parkerville do pay to my Daughter Magdalene Traine Thirteen  
Pounds Current Money but should the said negro Deed die before  
payment of my said debts then I reserve to my son Samuel Parkerville  
Executors & from the payment of Thirteen pounds Current Money to my  
Daughter Magdalene Traine or to her heirs &c  
I have also given and devised to my son Samuel Parkerville Charles and John  
and his heirs forever and should the said negro Charles or John die before  
payment of my debts already mentioned then I reserve to my son Samuel Parkerville  
the value of his heirs &c from the payment of one hundred pounds to the said  
or to my son Richard Parkerville challenge I have also given and  
devised to my son Samuel Parkerville one half of my stock of Sheep and Hogs to  
him and his heirs forever. I have also given and devised to my son William  
Parkerville the other half of my stock of Sheep and Hogs to him and  
his heirs forever. I have also given and devised all my stock of Cattle Horses and  
Carts to be equally divided between my son George Parkerville Richard  
Parkerville Samuel Parkerville William Parkerville and  
my Daughter Magdalene Traine to them and their heirs forever  
I have also given and devised to my son Samuel Parkerville and to William  
Parkerville all my household and kitchen furniture not  
mentioned all my oxen wagon and cart with the Blankets &c  
&c to them and their heirs forever. I have also given and devised all  
negroes with their families in or out of the said mentioned and the  
above mentioned to them their heirs and assigns forever  
I desire no appraisement of my estate and I appoint my son  
Parkerville my whole and sole Executor to do my last  
wishes according to all my former wills
