weak State of Health though of a Sound Mind and full Memory
do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament as follows
In the first place I commend my Spirit to God who gave me
and my Body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be Buried
in a Christian like decent Manner at the discretion of my Executors here
after mentioned and after my last debts and funeral Charges are paid
I dispose of my Estate in the following Manner
I leave unto my beloved wife Sarah the free use and enjoyment of
the Tract of Land which I now live together with all my Horse
Stock of Every kind Plantation utensils Household and Kitchen

I am now in my natural life except each part of my will as
as I have mentioned and bequeath to my children respectively
John, My Will is that my Tract of Land lying in the County of
Charlotte be equally divided according to the Value thereof
and it is my desire that my Friends William Marshall who lives
near my said Land, Nathaniel Price & Jacob Price Sons of William
Price of Prince Edward do ascertain the Value thereof and
divide the same to the best of their Judgment, which said division
I desire may be made as soon as my Son John Cox shall think
most expedient to him. I then give and bequeath unto my son
John Cox one half of my said Tract of Land in the County of
Charlotte according to the division above mentioned, and that
it is my will that my said Son John shall have the first Choice
of spots which said one half of my said Tract of Land in
the County of Charlotte I give and devise to my said son
John Cox for him and his heirs forever.
I then give and bequeath to my son Frederick Cox the other half of
my said Tract of Land in the County of Charlotte to him and
his heirs for ever. I then it is my Will that after my Wife's death
my Tract of Land on which I now live shall be equally divided
according to Quality and quantity by running a line from my
Back Creek in a straight direction to my back line over
which are Perry Road so as to leave my dwelling house on the
part a half that lies adjoining Thomas Bagley's land being on
the South side of that dividing line along with the
which said Tract of Land I divide as follows I then give
and bequeath to my son Price Cox one half of my said
Land on which I now live being the half that lies near
the Back Creek and lies northward of the dividing line
I have before directed to him my son Price Cox and his
heirs forever. I then the other half of my Tract of Land
on which I now live being the upper most half, I give and
bequeath to the half that lies South of the said
line and includes my Mansion House I give and devise
to my son Paul Cox for him and his heirs forever.
I then it is my Will that my son Paul Cox should do
me heirs to the age of 21 years, then in that case

 Twenty one years or sooner if his Mother think proper a Horse and
 Saddle also a good feather Bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever.
 I then give unto my son Patton Lee when he arrives to the age of
 Twenty one years or sooner if his Mother shall choose a horse and Saddle
 also a good feather Bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever. I then
 give unto my daughter Elizabeth Lee a horse and Saddle such as her
 Mother may think proper, also a good feather Bed and furniture to her
 and her heirs forever. I then give unto my daughter Nancy Lee when
 her Mother shall see convenient, a horse and Saddle also a good feather
 Bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever. I then give unto my daughter
 Polly Lee when her Mother shall see fit, a horse and Saddle also a good
 feather Bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever. I then give unto my daughter
 Sally Lee when her Mother shall see convenient, a horse and Saddle also a good
 feather Bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever. I then give unto my daughter
 Judith Lee when her Mother shall see proper, a horse and Saddle also a good
 feather Bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever. I then give unto my daughter

 her natural life and at her death my Wife is that such part of

give and bequeath unto my daughter Sally Core when her Mother shall
see fit, a horse and Saddle also a good feather Bed and
Furniture to her and her horsefearer. I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Judith Core when her Mother shall see fit, a horse and Saddle also a good
Bed and furniture to her and her horsefearer. I give and bequeath
unto my daughter Tabitha Core when her Mother shall see fit,
a horse and Saddle also a good feather Bed and
Furniture to her and her horsefearer. I give and bequeath
unto my wife when she shall see the need of any of my children
requiring to impart to them as she may think fit, so as to give their
share of that part of my Estate in her hands which I have lent her during
her natural life and at her decease my will is that such part of
my Estate as for all the remaining and not herein disposed of shall
be Equally divided among the whole of my children viz. Joseph
Leach, Isaac Core, Pric Core, Taitton Core, Elizabeth Leach, Nancy Core,
Polly Core, Sally Core, Judith Core & Tabitha Core them and their
heirs forever and lastly I do constitute and appoint my
worthy Friend of my beloved wife, Tabitha Core Jacob Michael
and my son John Core and my son in Law Joseph Leach to be the
Executors of the Execution of this my last will and Testament after my
Dying and discharging all my will by me made in Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this fifteenth day of
