the above mentioned Land and furniture & ornaments in
life I give & bequeath during her natural life.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Franklin that part
my Land which he now lives upon, that lies the North side
the Main Road also one driving Stake one Acre and two
Shroats to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my said son Pheen Fran-
lin that part of the Land which I now live upon my Wife
Nancy after her decease to him and his heirs forever
and further my Will and desire is that my two Daughters
Jocely Bailey and Judith Franklin shall live with my
Wife Nancy Franklin on the Land I now live upon
as long as they my said Daughters shall remain unmarried.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Wife Nancy Franklin my Negro Man
Sammy during her natural life, and at her decease my
Will is that the summing shall be sold together with the
one Acre of the Land I now live upon to her my said Wife and the
one equally divided among my three Daughters Jocely Bailey
Judith Franklin and Sarah Franklin (Belkinen) given
to them and to their heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Daughter Jocely Bailey two Beds the
one she lies upon and the one she lies upon also one Acre and
three Shroats two Copper Dishes, three Copper Plates
one Acre and two Shroats to her and to her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Judith Franklin
one rather Bed the one my son John Franklin formerly used
to lie upon, two Copper Plates, one Acre and two Shroats
and a Copper two Shroats to her and to her heirs forever.

Then I give and bequeath unto my said Son Peter Chan-
lin that part of the Land which I lent unto my Wife Mary
Franklin after her decease to him and his heirs forever
and further my Will and desire is that my two Daughters
Jacey Rosley and Judith Franklin shall live with me
until they are married on the Land I lent her my said
Daughter shall remain unmarried.
Then I lend my Wife Mary, Franklin my Negro Man
named Mary during her Natural life, and at her decease she
shall be sold to her my said Wife and the
Judith Franklin and my said Daughter Jacey Rosley
to them and to their heirs forever.
Then I give unto my Daughter Jacey Rosley her Bed the
trunk upon and the piece she lies upon also one Dress and
three Shirts two Copper Dishes, three Copper Plates
and one Pot to her and to her heirs forever.
Then I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Judith Franklin
the one my Son John Franklin formerly used
and before two years old, I give unto her and unto her heirs forever
my said Daughter Mary Franklin
five hundred and twenty Money that I have and to her heirs forever
I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Franklin five
hundred and twenty Money that I have and to his heirs forever
I give and bequeath unto my son John Franklin
five hundred and twenty Money to him and to his heirs
forever.
And I will constitute and appoint James Bag-

and my son Owen Franklin to be Executors of this my last
 Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
