County of Cumberland being of sound and disposing mind & Memory
do hereby declare this Day. In the Year one thousand seven hundred
and seventy six. Do make and Publish this my last will and Testament
as follows. (That is to say) I give and Devise unto my Wife Rachel
all the Tract of Land I now live on with the Tenements thereof
during her Natural Life and after her decease I give and Devise the
same unto my Brother Abraham Bough to him his Heirs and Assigns
forever. I likewise give unto my Wife Eleven Negroes their Names as follows
to wit. Bess, John, Aggrey, Kate, Jane, Isaac, Debbey, Amey, Betty, Sarah, to
her Heirs and Assigns forever with the Ornaments thereof. I
also give unto Thomas Bough Son of my Brother Abraham Bough
all that and County aforesaid one Negro Man Named Ned to be his
and his Heirs and Assigns forever. I give unto my Brother James Bough of Dale Parish in the
County of Chesterfield one Negro Girl Named Mary, with the Ornaments
thereof to be his Heirs and Assigns forever. I give to my Brother A
braham Bough the remainder of my Negroes the Names as follows to wit
to wit. Frank, Jack, Dimp, to be his with the Ornaments thereof.
I also leave Henry More and his wife
in their the use of my adjacent Plantation Negroes to live on during
their Natural life providing they continue there to live and not move
from the aforesaid Plantation and after their decease I give and Devise the
same unto Thomas Bough Son of Abraham Bough to him his Heirs
and Assigns forever. I leave unto Rachel Winfrey one Acre of Land lying
