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Edward Low, George James, Samuel Wilson, and Samuel Evans,  
(Juries) came into Court and severally took the Oath of Allegiance  
to the State, And are admitted to the rights of Citizenship.

Ordered that the Overseers of the poor bind out Leet Sheatwood  
Orphan of William Sheatwood, to Thomas \_\_\_\_\_ to learn the  
art and mystery of a millwright. According to Law.

On hearing the complaint exhibited against Benjamin Harris, by  
Benjamin Morby. It is ordered that the same be dismissed.

The last Will and Testament of Hezekiah Morby was presented in  
Court and proved by the Oath of Hens Sizer and William McLaurene,  
And was by the Court ordered to be recorded. — And on the motion  
of Colonel Lipscomb one of the executors therein named, who made Oath  
and together with Littleberry Morby his security, entered into, and acknow-  
ledged their Bond in the penalty of three thousand pounds conditioned  
as the Law directs. (Probate thereof is granted him on, due sworn.

Ordered that William McLaurene, Nicholas Sprau, Hans Sizer, Wm.  
Morby, And Littleberry Morby Junior, (any three of them being first  
sworn, before a Justice in the Commission of the peace for this County)  
do appraise in Current Money the Slave of any And personal Estate  
of Hezekiah Morby deceased, and return the appraisement to Court.

William Clarke Gent is appointed a Commissioner to receive the List of  
Taxable property in this County, in the room of William Morby Gent  
who resigned.
