Haskins In the name of God amen I Martha
Haskins of Powhatan county being of sound mind memory
understanding thanks be to almighty god for it do think it ne-
cessary to make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
in form following: Item I give and bequeath to my granddaugh-
ter Martha Gimney Mosby one negro girl named Gimney and
her increase to her and her heirs forever.

Item I lend unto my daughter Martha Gybbby during
the term of her natural life one negro girl named Beck Thor-
increase also my riding chair and bay mare and my Will
and desire is that at the death of my daughter Martha Gybbby
that the above mentioned property shall be equally divided
amongst the heirs of her body share and share alike to them
and their heirs forever.

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Item I give and bequeath unto my son Robert Haskins all
my lands lying in Chesterfield county which I purchased of
Barrett Mann & Robert Craig containing seven hundred and
eighty two acres be the same more or less. I also give him my
part of the crop that is growing on Black mare & sorrel colts
one grey horse, two feather beds & furniture. I also leave my
said son Robert Haskins to receive and pay all my just debts
and be entitled to all the profits thereof to him and his heirs
forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my son John
Haskins a Legacy of Two hundred pounds current money of
Virginia to be paid to him by my son Robert Haskins at my
death. I also give him two feather beds and furniture, one
bay mare called young one and one bay colt to him & his heirs forever.
Item I give and bequeath unto my son Abner Haskins one

negro woman named Lydia and her child shut up and all the increase they may ever have, one boy more called Fly his feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever.

Item My will and desire is that all the rest and residue of my estate whatsoever and wheresoever not herein before mentioned shall be equally divided between my three sons Robert, John and Isaac Haskins to them and their heirs and assigns forever.

And Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my son Robert Haskins executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former and other Wills by me at any time heretofore made and do confirm this my last Will and Testament.

At a Court held for Powhatan county the 1st day of December 1800 This last Will and Testament of Martha Haskins was presented in open court and proven by the oaths of Rebecca Halsey and Elizabeth Finney both the subscribing witnesses and admitted to record. And on the motion of Robert Haskins the executor therein named certificates is granted him for obtaining probat thereof in due form he having made oath and entered into bond with security in the penalty of Two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs.
