Ordered that John Swann, Josiah Smith, and James Clarke Esq, or any two of them do examine, state, and settle the account of Mary Cleavants as Administratrix of Charles Logan dec^d, and report the same to this Court.

On the motion of Philip Adams, who took the Oath of an Administrator as
prescribed by law, and together with John Adams his security entered into and
acknowledged their bond with the penalty of One thousand pounds, with condition according
