Wifes decease my will is that my Estate be divided
in the following manner and form. I give and
bequeath to my daughter Susannah Otterley one Negro
girl named Milley one Negro girl named Rachel
to her and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever.
I give and bequeath to my son John Jordan One
bed and furniture one Negro boy named George one Negro
boy named Frank to him and his heirs forever. I then
give unto my son Joseph Jordan One feather bed and furniture
One Negro boy named David one Negro Girl named Judith

to him and his heirs forever. I then give and bequeath to
 my daughter Elizabeth Jordan one feather bed and furniture
 one Negro girl named Lucy. One Negro woman named
 Molly to her and her heirs forever. I then give and be-
 queath to my Son Jesse Jordan one feather bed and furniture
 One Negro boy named Tom. One Negro boy named Ned to him
 and his heirs forever. I then my wife is then my Negro
 Woman Betty be sold and the money applied for the use
 of the ^{style} I then my wife and desire is after buying my coat of arms
 and legacies that my land and the remainder of my estate
 be sold and money equally divided amongst my three sons
 and two daughters namely Susan at 21, Elizabeth
 Joseph Elder and John Jordan to them and their heirs
 forever. I then I make Ordain and appoint Elizabeth
 my wife my Executors and my son John Jordan
 Roger my Executors of this my last will and testament
 do hereby utterly Revoke and annul all former wills and tes-

Bentley and George Smith their securities entered into an
acknowledges their bond in the penalty of five hundred
