In the name of God Amen I, Thomas Smith of the County of Powhatan being low in health, but of sound mind and memory do think proper to make this my last will and Testament, finally revoking all others heretofore made by me -

I give and bequeath unto my two Sisters Betsey Smith and Peggy I have my tract of Land lying in Halifax being out doors bounds estimated at three hundred and fifty acres, more or less to be equally divided between them I give to them and there heirs for ever -

I give and bequeath unto my Sister Phely One hundred pounds in specie to be collected out of my Fathers Estate, at the expiration of three years, after my decease, also one feather Bed to take possession of at my death -

I give and bequeath unto my niece Harriet West One hundred pounds in specie to be collected out of my fathers Estate, which

legacy I wish to remain in the hands of my friend Peter  
St Archer until my <sup>said</sup> niece Harriet should arrive to the age  
of Twenty one or married. I also request Peter St Archer to  
apply the s<sup>d</sup> money in any manner that he the s<sup>d</sup> Archer  
may think the most advantageous for the said Harriet, which  
money will not be due, until three years after my death.

I also give her one feather bed, to take possession of at my death  
Item I give and bequeath unto my sister Polly North fifty pounds  
Species to be collected out of my fathers Estate, at the Expiration of  
three years after my death.

Item I give and bequeath unto my niece Polly Walther Fifty pounds  
Species to be collected out of my fathers Estate at the Expiration of  
three years after my death.

Item It is my will and desire that all of my debts should be collected  
except the debts that is due from my Fathers Estate to me, and  
them to be collected at the expiration of three years after my death  
and appropriated as I have directed in this my last will and  
Testament.

Item It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid out of  
the money that is due me, and the residue to be left in the  
hands of William North of Prince Edward County, to go towards  
Educating my sister Wests Children (my niece Harriet excepted)  
I dont mean the money due me from my Fathers Estate, to be  
applied to the Education of my Sister Wests Children, but all other  
moneys that may be due me after my debts are paid, and of after  
they are educated the residue if any, it is then my wish that  
it shall be equally divided among all of my s<sup>d</sup> Sister Wests Children  
(Harriet excepted) To them and their Heirs for Ever -

I also give her one feather bed, to take possession of at my death  
Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Polly North fifty pounds  
Specie to be collected out of my fathers Estate, at the Expiration of  
three years after my death.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Niece Polly Walthell Fifty pounds  
Specie to be collected out of my fathers Estate at the Expiration of  
three years after my death.

Item It is my will and desire that all of my debts should be collected  
except the debts that is due from my Fathers Estate to me, and  
them to be collected at the expiration of three years after my death  
and appropriated as I have directed in this my last will and  
Testament.

Item It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid out of  
the money that is due me, and the residue to be left in the

Educating my sister Wests Children (my Niece Harriot excepted)  
I do hereby mean the money due me from my Fathers Estate, to be  
applied to the Education of my Sister Wests Children, but all other  
moneys that may be due me after my debts are paid, and if after  
they are educated the residue of any, it is then my wish that  
it shall be equally divided among all of my Sisters Wests Children  
(Harriot excepted) To them and their Heirs for Ever.

I do hereby appoints May Peter Archer John Smith, and William  
North my Executors to see my last Will and testament, given from  
under my hand and seal this Tenth day of June in the year of  
our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and four.
