I give to my beloved son John Tucker my negro man Lewis also Twenty five pounds to be collected from the sale of my property hereafter mentioned. I give to my beloved son Thomas Tucker Fifty pounds to be collected from the sale of my property hereafter mentioned. I give to my beloved daughter-in-law Sarah Tucker, now the widow of my beloved son Elisha Tucker, Fifty pounds to be collected from the sale of my property hereafter mentioned. It is my wish will and desire that my land & stock of every kind not before mentioned as also my household and kitchen furniture not already mentioned be sold over a period of Twelve months and should the amount of such sale be over the amount of the sums already mentioned in my will it is my wish will and desire that such amount be it small or

 of Twelve months and should the amount of such sale be over the
 amount of the sums already mentioned in my will it is my
 wish will and desire that such amount be it small or
 great be divided equally between my two sons Jesse Tucker &
 John Tucker or their legal representatives
