At a court held for Powhatan county the 19th
day of April 1809. This last will and testament of Wm
Brummer dec^d was presented in court and proved by the
oaths of William Wallhall and Gallo Wilkinson two subscri-

motion of James R. Stokes the executor therein named
certificate is granted him for obtaining probat thereof
in due form he having made oath and entered into
bond with security as the law directs
