This last Will & Testament of Ambrose Inge deceased was presented in court and proved by the oaths of John Hundley and James Pavis two of the Witnesses thereto ~~certified~~ that the same be recorded in the motion of Henry Inge the only Executrix therein named who with Gabriel Vass & John Hundley her securities entered into and acknowledged their bond for that purpose in the penalty of five Hundred dollars ^{with addition of interest and costs} and took the oath required by Law certificate for obtaining a probat thereof in due form is granted here.
