in perfect health and memory do make this my last Will and Testament.
Wiz my desire is that my funerals Expenses should be first paid,
and then my Just debts to be paid by my Executors hereafter Named.
Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Gradick two Coats & Cloves
and one feather Bed which things she has now in possession, also
five shillings to be paid unto her. Item I bequeath unto my Son John
one Negro Man named Peter in dowering his Matril life. and then
I give the said Negro to his son Bartholomew, If my son John should
sell or put the said Peter out of his possession my desire is that my
Executors should take the said Negro, in possession for the good of
my son John's eldest son, I also give unto my son John one
horse which he has now in possession, Item I bequeath unto my daughter
Sarah Type one Negro Woman named Patt & her Child in dowering
her Matril life, and then to be equal divided between my daughter
Sarah Children; I give unto my Daughter Sarah one feather Bed.
Item I bequeath unto my daughter Luekey W. Scammon one Negro
Girl named Mitley in dowering her Matril life and then to be
Equal divided between my Daughters Children; I give unto my

Equal divid betwen my Daughters Childress; I give unto my
said daughter one feather Bed which she has now in pession.
Here I give unto my Daughter Judy Therman one Negor Woman
named Poll and her two Childress David & Harri. Here I give
unto my Son Charles two Negos Viz, Donah and Tim one mare
and all my hogs & Cattle, Here I give unto my son Nathan
four Negros Viz: Jacob & Lucy, Lewis & Dinah and my two Mares.
I do appoint Jacob Woodson & Stephen Pettus my Executors, I do
renounce all other Wills hertofore made as Witnefs my hand and
Seal this ninth day of February one thousand seven hundred and
Eighty six.

Testament of ~~Bartho~~ Bartholomew Zachery deceased was presented in Court and proved by
Dick Holland and James Coleman two of the Witnefs thereto and ordered to be recorded.

 August the 16th 1791 this Will was further proved by James
 Clarke another witness thereto and ordered the records
 Susanna Elizabeth Scott, widow of said decedent in Court
 relinquished her right to take execution of said Will, thereupon
 on the Motion of Thomas Scott and Richard Bibb then
 Executors in said Will named, who gave bonds and security
 and took the oath required by Law, Certificate for
 obtaining a probat thereof in due form is granted them.

At a Court held for Prince Edward County December 13th
 1796 the Executors in said Will, and John Fackery
 son and Heir at Law of said Bartholomew,
 also in Court refused to take Administration of said Estate,
 Therefore on the Motion of William Tyne who gave
 bond and took the oath required by Law, Administⁿ
 on of the Estate of said Bartholomew Fackery deceased
 is granted him with the Will annexed
