I Charles Parish of Prince Edward County being in a low state of health in body but sound in mind make this my last will, and dispose of my worldly estate as follows. I give to my son Robert one Negro woman named Lure and Child which Negroes he has now in possession them and their Increase to him and his heirs forever. I give to my daughter Patsy one Negro Girl named Betty and all her future Increase to her heirs forever which said Negro she has now in possession. I lend to my ^{daughter} Elizabeth Corner during her natural life one negro girl named Martha and all her future Increase. But her increase I give the said Negro and her increase to be equally divided amongst the heirs lawfully begotten of her body. I give to my son Charles one Negro Girl named Litty and all her future Increase. I lend to my Daughter Nancy during her natural life one Negro Girl named Fanny, and at her decease I give the said Negro and her increase to be equally divided amongst the heirs of her body lawfully begotten. I give to my son Daniel Price one Negro Girl named Kate and all her future Increase. I give to my son William ~~one~~ Negro girl named Dix and all her future Increase. I give to my son Joseph Pate one negro girl named Litter and all her future Increase. I lend to my daughter Agnes during her natural life one negro boy named Lipe and also one Negro girl to be purchased by or born in my Estate, and at her decease I give the said Negroes and their Increase to be equally divided amongst her heirs lawfully begotten of her body, and I also give to my seven youngest Children namely Elizabeth Corner, Charles, Nancy, Daniel Price, William, Joseph Pate, & Agnes to each of them one young horse Saddle & Bridle one fathers bed and furniture also one Cow and Calf, when they become of ^{age} or marry and my will is that I sh

and day, when they become of or marry and my will is that if either of the
Negroes lent to my Daughters, or given to my sons should die before they have their
portion for them to have another out of my Estate of equal Value in lieu thereof. I lend
to my beloved wife Agnes during her natural life one hundred and fifty Acres of Land
with my plantation and houses wherein I now live also five Negroes namely Robin, Jane,
Lucy, Melly and Anthony likewise I lend to my wife during her widowhood the residue
of my lands and Negroes not heretofore mentioned for the purpose of raising and schooling
my children also my household and kitchen furniture likewise all my stock of every
kind with my plantation utensils and after the death of my wife my will is that the
whole of my Estate not before given be equally divided amongst all my Male Children
Children, and it is my will, that my Estate be ^{not} ~~not~~ Appraised nor sold and that my Executors
may not be held to Security and lastly I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Agnes and
my son Robert, the sole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament I do
Witness that I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty
third day of January one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight

At a Court held for Prince Edward County June 18th 1798

This last will and Testament of Charles Pinck Deceased was presented in Court and proved by the Oaths of William Pinck and Nathaniel Pinck two of the Nearest thereto Relatives that the same be Recorded, and on the motion of Agnes Pinck one of the Executors therein named (No bounty being required by law) the said Agnes Pinck interceded and acknowledged her bond in the sum of five thousand dollars for that purpose Conditioned as the Law directs and took the oath required by Law Certificate for obtaining a probate thereof in due form is granted her and leave given the other Executor therein named to take Execution thereof at another day
