First I leave unto my loving wife Frances Rice the Land and Plantation whereon I now
live together with all kinds of Stocks therein the Household and Kitchen Furniture
with all the Stock of Corn and other grain thereon during her Natural life or

Misfortune who during and Maintaining the Children out of the Profits of the
same and after her Decease a Widowhood my will and desire is that the

whole of my Estate be sold at Publick sale and converted into Money and by the
same amongst those my Children that shall then be living & so thereby
I leave my brother James Rice and my said wife Frances Rice Executors and
assigns to execute the my last will and Testament and I wish the
Wills by me here before made to be published to be my last will
& Testament & in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
fourth day of the month of June the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and

thirteen
