Memory do make and ordain this to be my Last Will and
testament in manner and form following -

First I give and bequeath is that all just debts be paid

Then I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Judith
Negroes five Negroes named Jerry, Will, Ballas for the
time to her and her heirs forever also my wearing apparel

Then I give and bequeath unto my Son Obadiah Woodson
one Large Bed to him and his heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto my Son David Woodson
fifty pounds Current money of Virginia to him this half

Then I give and bequeath unto my son Jacob Woodson
two Negroes named Molly and Little Jack also and

Then I give and bequeath unto my son David Woodson
one Bed and one Feather Bed and furniture
also two Cows and Calves to him and his heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto my son David Woodson
five Negroes named Isaac, Mal, Piny, Apple & Peter to him
and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my son Charles Woodson Jones
Negro named, Jack, Phillis of my, Lucy and Coton to him
and his heirs forever,

I give and bequeath all the remainder of my Estate
of what nature or kind soever, to be equally divided
between my aforesaid Sons Daniel and Charles, to them &
their heirs forever.

My further Will and desire is that if either of
or Charles Woodson's should Depart this life under the age of
Twenty one years and without issue that all the Estate given to
each of my said Sons during as aforesaid shall go and be
to the surviving of them to him and his heirs forever.

And I do ordain and direct that all the Estate heretofore
devised to my said Sons Daniel or Charles Woodson be left and
remain in the Possession of my Executors hereafter mentioned
to be by them held out or otherwise as my Executors shall
think fit and most advantageous for the support
and Education of my said sons Daniel and Charles
and until all my just debts and a Legacy of Fifty pounds
to my son David be paid, And lastly do nominate
Constitute and appoint my Friends Abraham H. H. H.

and until all my just debts and a legacy
to my son David be paid. And lastly do now
constitute and appoint my friends Abraham Bonable
Nathaniel Venable and Francis Watkins Executors of this
my last Will and Testament hereby reciting and
disavowing all other and former Will or Wills by me made
made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this Seventeenth day of July in the
year of Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy

three

 Woodson, with the usual appraisers
 and Certificate for obtaining Letters he has
 first having given bond and Security and taken the
 oath required by Law.
