of my Existence and my <sup>body</sup> to the grave, there to rest in hopes of a future  
Resurrection and glorious Immortality, and as to such worldly goods  
where with hath pleased God to bless me I dispose of them in the following  
manner. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Cunningham  
a Negro Wench named Charity also five pounds Cash. I give and  
bequeath to my two Daughters Jane Chandler and Sarah Tachery to each  
the Sum of five pounds Cash. I Give and bequeath to my Son William  
Hay my tract of Land on Spring Creek containing one hundred & Seventy  
Nine Acres, also my Stock & House furniture. Together with all other  
property of what ever Description that I am now possessed of and  
not herein before mentioned. I do hereby nominate and appoint my Son  
William Hay & John Daniel <sup>Deputies</sup> Executors of this my last will and Testament  
and do hereby make Void all former Wills & Legacies by me made In  
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Twelfth  
day of April 1785.

I do hereby bequeath to my Son William  
my tract of Land on Spring Creek Containing one hundred & Seventy  
Nine acres, also my Stock & House furniture. Together with all other  
property of what ever Description that I am now possessed of and  
not herein before mentioned. I do hereby nominate and appoint my Son  
William Hay & John Daniel Executors of this my last will and Testament  
and do hereby <sup>repealed</sup> make Void all former Wills & Legacies by me made In  
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Twelfth  
day of April 1785.
