Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Henry Ligon One Bed and
Furniture as it stands to him and his Heirs or Assigns forever
Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Ligon One Bed
and Furniture as it stands to her and her Heirs forever
Item I Give and bequeath unto my son William Ligon One of the best

of land that I own in London Beginning at the front of the house
Branche and up to the Branch of the road as follows the land
Branche and half the land and also one Negro Boy named
Jacob and also one Negro girl named Jane and also one Negro
Boy named Sam to him his heirs or assigns forever
I now give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Ligon one Negro
Boy named Jay and also one Negro Boy named Matthew and
also one Negro Boy named Peter and also one Bad and
Furniture with stands and also one harness with saddle and
Bridle and also two cows and calves to her and her heirs
or assigns forever

I now give and bequeath to my Well Beloved Wife Sarah Ligon all that remain
in part of my Negro Slaves and all my moveables to her and her
heirs or assigns forever and also lend her the remainder part
of the Tract of Land lying my son William Ligon above
mentioned during his widowhood or until she dies and
Bequeath the whole Tract of Land to my son William Ligon to
him his heirs or assigns forever.

And lastly I constitute and appointing Will Beloved Wife
Sarah Ligon and my son Henry Ligon, S^{rs} of this my
Last Will and Testament hereby making all other former
Wills made by me, Acknowledging and confirming this
to be my Last Will and Testament. My Witnesses thereof
Have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this
Twelfth Day of November One thousand seven hundred
and fifty nine e e e
