At a Court held for Prince Edward County July the 18th 1803
purporting to be the last will and Testament of Henry Smith decd was presented
in Court and on hearing the parties concerned by Counsel the same being
proved in due form of Law by William Dunnivant a Witness thereto who
deposeth and saith that Susanna Pemberton Dunnivant the other Witness
Witness to the said Will is dead that to the best of his belief her Signature was
made in his presence and in the presence of the Testator at his request and
that he the said William Dunnivant cannot write nor discern
one hand writing from another Ordered that the same be recorded
