to take notice that he intended the said Testamentary words, should
be his last Will, and that they believe he was in his perfect senses and memory
and ordered to be recorded.

who made it. and I do leave and bequeath to my beloved wife Anne the
whole management of the Land and ^{all} my other effects in order to raise
the family and as she come to the years of Discretion let her divide
among them according as her Lock will afford and if at any time
she sees cause to sell the Land I do empower her to sell it and
make a sufficient right to the purchaser agreeable to the Laws of this State,
this is the true intent and meaning of my ^{last} Will and Testament Given
under my hand and seal this 2. day of October and coming 1784.

In the Name of God Amen I Sarah Watts of the County of Prince Edward now possessing perfect Faculty of mind & Memory, Constitute and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. Inprimis I give and bequeath to my beloved Brother John Watts the following Negroes, Rob, Phillis, Charles, Darry, James, Molly, Daphney, Maria to him and his heirs forever. Item my Will and desire is, that after the payment of my Just debts out of the money to be Collected which is due me, my brother John Watts shall take the residue, (if there be any) to him and his heirs. And direct that my cloths shall be equally divided between my sister Elizabethth Tucker & my Niece Elizabethth Watts. finally I appoint my Brother John Watts Executor of this my last Will, hereby Revoking all former wills by me heretofore made.
