live or during his life and after his death I will and desire my
said land with all appurtenances to be given unto my Grandson
and his Heirs he or his Heirs shall be bound to come of age or be an
Heir of his body then I will and desire the same land with my Grand-
son Samuel Shephard son of William Shephard and his Heirs forever
also I give and bequeath unto my two daughters Frances & Polly
all my other Estate not herebefore given or bequeathed equally divided
between them but now well and desire is that my two Sons David
and Daniel be valued and that my daughter Frances have her

and his three half brothers all before he comes of age, and as
I have of his body then full and entire the same land unto my Grand-
son Samuel Shepherd son of Michael Shepherd and his three sons,
also I give and bequeath unto my two daughters Frances & Patsy
all my other Estate not heretofore given away to be equally divided
between them. but my will and desire is that my two Sons David
and Daniel be satisfied and that my daughter Frances have her
choice of Time and that she pay to the other or receive the difference
of the Valuation of the two Shares also I will and desire that my
daughter Frances live in the house I now live in as long as she
lives unmarried without being interrupted. And lastly I hereby
appoint my son Samuel Shepherd and Abner Lockhart my Executors
after my last Will and Testament being reading all the same
