I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Legoe all my tract of land
lying in Prince Edward county on both sides of Sandy River also all my
negroes that now have in possession (Wife) Harry, John, Murdock, Thomas
Frederick, Joe, Henry, Rucker, Moll, Silas, Nicholas, Ann, John, Lucy
Mary, George, Amanda, Rose (daughter of Henry) old Lucy and Moll also
my stock of every kind, household & Kitchen furniture plantation utensils
& my crop of Corn Wheat and Tobacco that is or shall be growing at the time
of my death to him and his heirs forever. Item it is my will & desire that
all my Just debts should be paid out of the Estate hereofore given to my son

all my last debts should be paid out of the Estate heretofore given to my son
