being at this time in perfect sense and sound Memory do make and
ordain this my last will and Testament

Impetuous I give and bequeath to my son Beverly Collicot all my
Land between the Railton Branch and James Jennings line
to him and his heirs forever. Also I give and bequeath to my son

Beverly Collicot one Negro woman named Phetis also sixteen
Pounds two shillings in Cash and all the Debts justly Due to me
and equal part of the Crop that now grows on the Plantation

Item I give and bequeath to my son Harrison Collicot one Bay Horse
and half my stock of cattle Hogs and Sheep he paying and discharging
all my lawfull and just Debts to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Bailey Collicot the land and
and plantation whereon I now live and half my stock of cattle
Hogs and Sheep and equal part of the Crop that is now growing on
the Plantation to him and his heirs forever but if my son Bailey

Collicot should never Return from the army my will and Desire
is that my son Beverly Collicot and Harrison Collicot to have the Land
and money equally Divided between them both

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Collicot
one Negro woman named Beek and her increase to her and her

to own two plantings in back and all the Debt justly due to me
and equal part of the crop that now grows on the Plantation
Item I give and bequeath to my son Harrison Collicott my little
and half my stock of battle hogs and sheep he paying and discharging
all my lawfull and just Debts to him and his heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath to my son Bailey Collicott the land and
and plantation whereon I now live and half my stock of battle
Hogs and sheep and equal part of the crop that is now growing on
the Plantation to him and his heirs forever but if my son Bailey
Collicott should never return from the army my will and desire
is that my son Beverly Collicott and Harrison Collicott to have the land
and money I equally divided between them both.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Collicott
one Negro woman named Beck and her increase to her and her
heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my living wife Agatha Collicott the
house and Plantation I now live in during her natural life
and all the house hold Ethiopian Furniture of every kind during
her natural life I also bequeath to my well beloved wife one negro
woman named Dick during her life time after her decease the

three sons Beverly Collicot and Bailey Collicot and Harrison Collicot
I have and nominate my two sons Beverly Collicot and
Harrison Collicot my sole Executors to execute and comply with this
my last will and testament in Michigan whereof I have hereunto
my hand and seal this 1st day of August 1778
