Judience Hudson and William Baldwin or either of them to be my sole Executors to
execute and comply with this my last will and Testament in all things which I do here
unto set my hand and seal this ninth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred

32. A Court held for Prince Edward County July 21. 1800 This last will or testament
of James Hudson deceased was presented in Court and proved by the oaths of Faushee Blount
and John Hudson two of the Witnesses thereto. & Ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of
William Baldwin one of the Executors therein named gave bond and took the Oath required
by law. Certificate for obtaining a probat in due form is granted him and leave given the

mind and Memory do make and ordain this my last will and Testament as follows:
I give and devise to my son Josiah my Land and plantation lying in Prince Edward
County on Rutledge's Road, likewise one Gray mare Colt to be freely enjoyed &
disposed by him and his Heirs forever. If my son Josiah should die having no heir lawfully
born of his own body, then in that case I give and devise the above mentioned Land
& plantation to my four Daughters viz. Elizabeth Allen, Kesiah Allen, Betty Ann
Harrison & Susannah Nelson after the death of Josiah.
