Will

In the name of God Amen I James Price of the County of Prince
Edward doth make this my last will and Testament in manner
following that is to say - I give unto my wife Susanah Price one
half of my Stocks of every kind and one half of my household
and kitchen Furniture to be by her disposed at her death as she may
think proper but my desire nevertheless is that the half of my
stocks &c given to my wife as above shall be kept by my executors as
a joint stock with the other half of my stocks &c. for the support
of my wife and four children until they respectively arrive
to the different periods hereafter directed for them to withdraw
their proportion of my estate at which different periods the half so
given to my wife the joint stock is not to be considered subject
to them to draw any part thereof but that they draw their propor-
tions out of the other half and at the this reserve I desire that my
wife may at any time at her death dispose of the said half by
this will given her.

I give to my daughter Patsy Venable Price at such time as my
Executors shall think proper to deliver the same to her one
Negro Girl between the age of twelve and eighteen years.

I give to my daughter Sally Price at such time as my Executors shall think proper to deliver the same to her one Negro girl between the age of twelve and Eighteen years.

I desire that my wife as long as she lives may quietly and peaceably possess my dwelling house and other houses with two hundred acres of land adjoining.

I desire that my estate be kept together for the use and maintenance of my wife and four children to wit William Price, John Morton Price, Patsy Venable Price, and Sally Price and that as either of my said two

sons ~~arrive~~ respectively to the age of twenty one years and my daughters

arrive to the age of twenty one years or are married that they respectively

withdraw an equal share or one fourth part of my personal estate

consisting of Slaves stocks house hold and kitchen furniture crops

profits &c except that part of my stocks &c already given to my wife

and that the remainder of my estate be again continued as a general

stock in conjunction with the half given to my wife should share

above until the next hitch with draws his or her part.

I give unto my son William Price as soon as he arrives to the age of twenty one years one hundred and seventy nine and three quarter acres of Land which I bought of Mary Bassel and John Johnson I also give him after the death of his mother one half of the Land lent her during her life.

I give unto my son John Morton Price as soon as he arrives to the age of twenty one years one hundred and eighty seven acres of Land part of the tract I purchased of William Shellen to be taken off from the upper end of said tract. I also give my said son John M. Price the remaining half of the Land lent my wife during her life which remains in our I desire shall include the dwelling house spring &c.

I desire that if either of my sons should die before they arrive to the age of twenty one years that my other son should have the Land given to such dying son and that the other estate given to the son so dying shall be divided among the survivor or survivors of my other three children share and share alike or their legal representatives.

Then that my daughters or the survivor or survivors of them or their
Legal ^{representatives or} representatives equally divide the lands given to my said sons
or if either of my daughters die before they arrive to the age of twenty
one years the estate given them by this Will be equally divided amongst
all my surviving children or their legal representatives.

I desire my children shall be well educated as to English education
to be paid out of the profits of my Estate.

I desire my executors shall have my house finished and add a wing
at the east end and a porch at each side door as a further addition
to the house which I direct shall be paid for out of the profits of my estate.

Lastly I appoint my wife Susannah Price and my two
brothers William Price and Nathaniel Price my executors to this
my last will and Testament hereby revoking and making void
all other will or wills heretofore by me made and ratifying and
confirming this and only this to be my last will and Testament.
