Edward County in said Parish do make and ordain this my
last Will & Testament, as to what goods and estate, at last pleased
Almighty God to give me in this world I devise, dispose, give and
bequeath in manner and form as followeth.

Item I leave, devise and for the Use, Support and maintenance of my
Wife, during the term and term of her Natural Life, Town, Place
(to wit) Shott, Wile, Town, &c. and if needed, I give my Negro
Woman named Phillis and likewise one fourth part of my
Personal Estate

Item I give to my Daughter Martha the Wife of Hugh Shatt my two
Negro Girls named Mary and Elizabeth who were born of my
Mulatto Woman Phillis, as also the service of my said Daughter
Martha, but to return to my Estate after my decease.

Item I give to my Daughter Anne the Wife of William Baldwin
my Mulatto Woman named Agnes, and her Increase from
this time

Item I give to my Daughter Sarah, the Wife of the Reverend Mr. James
Gordon my Mulatto Woman named Sue, and her Bed and
Furniture which they have already in possession.

Item I give to my Son James Winkish my Negro Man named
Mingo and my Negro Boy named Harry with what he

Item I give to my Daughter Anne the Wife of William Baldwin
my Mulatto Woman named Agnes, and her Increase from
thence

Item I give to my Daughter Sarah, the Wife of the Reverend Mr James
Gordon my Mulatto Woman named Sue, and her Increase and
Increase which they have already in possession.

Item I give to my Son James Kimball my Negro Man named
Mingo and my Negro Boy named Harry with what he
has received from me.

Item I give to my Daughter Mary, the Wife of James Shackleton
Twenty four pounds current notes raised out of my Estate and
that in Cash in twelve Months after my decease.

Item I give to my three Younger Sons (to wit) Samuel, John and
Benjamin Kimball, all my Land and House not already
disposed of. As well as the 10000 for them during my life
during his life as others after his decease the whole to be
equally divided amongst my above named three Younger
Sons together with the increase of the remainder of my
Estate to them for ever for ever In testimony whereof.

As per my last described mentioned taking my whole and full
benefit of this my last will and testament in the sum of
thirty thousand pounds sterling and that this first day
of February last thousand seven hundred & sixty one
