Watton Moore his Heirs and assigns.
Item, I give and bequeath all the residue of my Estate of every kind
(to wit) my Lands, Slaves, Stock of every ^{kind} household Furniture working
Tools &c to my Father & Mother George Watton & Martha Watton
theirs and assigns forever And Lastly I constitute the said George
& Martha the whole and sole Executor of this my Last Will
desiring that no appraisement or Inventory be taken of the same.
And I do declare this only to be my last Will making all other
void & of no Effect witness my hand and Seal this 11th day of March
