This Last Will and Testament of John Cardwell deceased was presented in Court and proved by the Oath
of Joseph Ruppell and James Cardy two of the Witnesses thereto. Ordered that the same be Read
and at another Court held for said County June 18th 1798 the Last Will and Testament of John Cardwell Deceased was
presented on Court and on the Motion of George Cardwell one of the Executors therein named who with John Hollaway
and John Hollaway his heirs and assigns entered into and Acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand
Conditioned as the Court directs, thereupon the said George Cardwell took the oath required by Law for the
obtaining a probate thereof in and from the Court for the County of Essex.
