

In the Name of God Amen

The Twentieth Day of March in the Year of our Lord 1668 John
Davidson of Matonay parish in the County of Pembrokeshire
being very sick and weak in Body but of Perfect mind and Memory having
bequeathed unto God therefore willing unto and the mortality of my Body
knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to Die, I do make and
Ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all
I give and bequeath my Soul into the hands of God that hath it and for my
Body I bequeath it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian and decent
Manner by my Executors Notwithstanding but at the General Resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching my
Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life I give
Devise and Dispose of the same in the following manner and form

First I give and bequeath to Anne my dearly beloved Wife my whole Estate as
long as she please God she live and after her Death to be Divided in the
following manner and form

First I give and bequeath To my beloved Son William Davidson One hundred Acres

Impressio. I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Son Richard Davidson an equal part of
Estate excepting Land only Six pence five shillings and three pence for
Labour of it that the Estate is Obligated to pay God Good for him

Impressio. I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Son Joshua Davidson having no Land
Twenty pound Current Money of Virginia with an equal part of my other
Estate excepting Land

Impressio. I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Son Samuel Davidson One hundred Acres of
Land upon Mountain given with an equal part of my other Estate

Impressio. I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Daughter Elizabeth Davidson an equal part of
my Estate excepting Land Impressio. I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Son George Davidson
an equal part of my other Estate

Impressio. I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Son Ambrose Davidson One Hundred Acres of
Land requiring the Brother George Davidson with an equal part of my other Estate

Now I Give to my dearly Beloved Wife and my dear Beloved two Sons William and Joshua
Davidson whom I likewise constitute make and Create my only and Sole Executors
of this my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and the day and year above Written
