payment of my just debts.

3rd I Give and Bequeir to my Brother Stephen Depewitt that part
of my Fathers Estate given me by my Father in his Last will and
Testament in cash (to wit) Sixty Pounds which gift includes and
tho' from having any claim in my Estate in consequence of a debt due
him from me I give it to him ^{him} forever.

do of my Estate including my proportion of my Fathers Estate when
the Division takes place be it of What nature or Quality given to
her & her heirs I give it forever. And it is my desire that my Estate may
not be Appraised and I do constitute and Appoint my two Friends
Christopher Dyerrett and Josiah Burkeson Executors of my Last Will
and Testament revoking all others. In witness whereof I have here-
unto set my Hand and affixed my Seal this fourteenth day of
April 1790.

At a Court held for Prince Edward County July 19th 1790 This
Last Will and Testament of John Dyerrett deceased was presented in
Court and proved by two of the Witnesses thereto, and ordered to be
recorded; And on the Motion of Christopher Dyerrett who gave bond
and Security, & took the Oath required by Law Certificate for ob-
taining a probat thereof in due form is granted him; and leave
for the other Execution therein named to take Execution thereof at
another day.
