 beloved wife Frances Fix the fourth part of my negroes horses stock of all kinds
 house hold and kitchen furniture during her life also it is my desire that if she
 should marry and have children the property I have lent her should belong
 to her children lawfully begotten also it is my desire that she should keep
 possession of the whole of my lands as long as she lives my widow and after her
 death to belong to my son Wilson Fix and to his heirs forever, provided the child
 she is big with now should be a boy that he shall have an equal part of the
 land also it is my desire that the other three fourths of my personal property
 should be equally divided between my two children Wilson Fix and Abigail
 Fix also the one she is big with also it is my desire that my desire that
 my children shall take possession of their part when come of age or marry and
 lastly I leave James Fix Son and my wife Frances Fix my whole and sole
 Executors

A Court held in Lincoln County September the 19th 1803.
The last will and testament of John Flix deceased was presented in court and
acknowledged by the oath of Archibald Flix a witness thereto and Jesse Flix
and Reuben West on oath say that the said John Flix signed the said Will
in their presence and also acknowledged it to be his last will and testament ordered
that the same be recorded and on the motion of James Flix the executor: Therein
named who with Archibald Flix and John C. Cunningham his securities into and
acknowledged their bond for that purpose in the penalty of two hundred pounds
and condition according to law and the said James Flix took the oath required by
Law. Thereupon certificate for obtaining probate thereof in due form is granted him
and leave given the executor therein named to take execution thereof at another
day
