this to be my last will and Testament in the manner or I form
following.

First I give desire and bequeath to my son John Rowlett
one Negro man named Jimmey to him and his heirs forever

Also I give desire and bequeath to my son Mackinzie
half the land I now live on I shall hereafter make
of also one Negro man named Sam to him and his heirs forever

Also I give desire and bequeath to my son William Rowlett
the other half the land I now live on not yet before given
away also one Negro boy named Rafe to him and his heirs
forever

Also I give desire and bequeath to my Daughter Mary
Rowlett one Negro woman named Kate also one feather
Bed and furniture that she is now possessed with to her
and heirs forever.

Also I give desire and bequeath to my Daughter Prudence
Richardson one Shilling to her and her heirs forever
also the Residence of my Estate not yet given away I desire
may be equally divided Between all

Also I give Desire and Bequeath to my son Macknefs
half one half the land I now live in as shall hereafter make
of also one Negro man named Sam to him and his heirs for ever
also I give Desire and bequeath to my son William Rowlett
the other half the land I now live in not yet before given
away also one Negro boy named Rafe to him and his heirs
for ever

Also I give desire and bequeath to my Daughter Mary
Rowlett one Negro woman named Kate also one feather
Bed and furniture that she is now possessed with to her
and heirs forever.

Also I give desire and bequeath to my Daughter Prudence
Dickerson one Shilling to her and her and heirs forever
also the Residence of my Estate not yet given away I desire
may be Equally divided between all of my children
except Prudence Dickerson and that my Executor or Executors
named pay all my just Debts and funeral Expenses and
lastly I Appoint my two sons John and Macknefs Rowlett
aforesaid Executors of this my will and Testament in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
twenty third Day of October 1776 signed sealed and
delivered in the Presence of
