I Joel Clarke being of sound mind and memory make this my
last will and testament in manner and form following after
paying my just debts, I give and bequeath, to Howson Clarke
my younger brother all my estate, both real and personal
including all debts which now or hereafter shall be due to
me, to him and his heirs and for ever I appoint Howson
Clarke my only Executor to this my last will and testament
Given under my hand and seal this 16th October 1800 and in the

At a Court held for Prince Edward County December the 19th 1803
This last will and testament of Joel Clarke deceased was presented
in court and proved by the oaths of John Clarke Jun^r and William
W. Sudbery two of the witnesses thereto ordered that the same be
recorded. On the motion of Howson Clarke the only executor therein
named who with Thomas Clarke and Joseph Legin his securities
entered into and acknowledged their bond for that purpose in
the penalty of four thousand pounds and conditioned according to
Law and took the oath
